



2022 Jeepspeed Trophy Class (4700) Rules

Commencing: January, 1 2022

Jeepspeed Trophy Unlimited Class 4700 will be identical to Jeepspeed Outlaws Modified Class 3700 but with following exceptions. Please read 3700 rules thoroughly. [3700 Rules](#)

4.0 CLASS RULES:

4.1.1 Body. Must use Jeep or Dodge radiator grill , Dodge/Jeep-style headlamp or headlamp decals and Jeepspeed supplied body side Dodge/Jeep logos. **Beginning in 2023, all vehicles must have a Jeep or Mopar body (Dodge, Ram).**

4.2.1 Wheel-base restricted to 123" on custom chassis vehicles, any Jeep or Dodge bodied vehicle constructed or raced prior to publication of these rules may apply for a variance at the discretion of Jeepspeed.

4.2.2.1 Front wheel travel 18" max. Rear wheel travel open.

4.2.2.2 Maximum tire size 37" diameter - Open

4.2.2.3 Mandated KMC Series Wheels (or other approved American Racing wheel or Wheel Pros brands wheel) KMC decals must be displayed.

4.5.1 Engine block may be any make 4/6/8 cylinder but must be a production block or available in crate or component form to the general public in the USA. Engine block may be modified but must maintain the same number of cylinders as originally equipped. Heads must be available to the general public in the USA. Must maintain the same number of valves as the engine was originally equipped. 4 or 6 cylinder engines may be turbo or supercharged. No underdrive or overdrive systems.

4.8.1 Chassis is open.

4.8.1.1 Tube chassis Wheelbase must not exceed 123". If the vehicle uses complete length production factory chassis you may apply for wheelbase variance.

4.8.1.3 Class 3700 rule not applicable.

4.8.1.4 Engine and transmission location. Must be ahead of rear axle assembly. Transmission must be a production-based unit. Open modifications. No sequential gearboxes.

4.8.2.5 Class 3700 rule not applicable.

All vehicles must use Tires Max Dia. 37" All vehicles must use KMC Wheels, or a wheel brand of the 8 Wheel Pros Inc makes. (American Racing, ATX, etc.) www.jeepspeed.com. For more details. Jeepspeed retains the right to change or modify the rules at any time. Jeepspeed will do its best to give competitors fair notice of any changes.



5.0 SUPPLEMENTARY RULES:

Addendum 2020 Jeepspeed New rule: All Jeepspeed classes will require a minimum of 2 seats and a maximum of 3 seats. Teams must conform with Best in the Desert rules. All seats must be occupied. DRIVERS— CO-DRIVERS SDC1: Each seat in any race vehicle must be occupied during the entire duration of the event as long as the vehicle remains in competition. The maximum number of seats allowed in any Class is three (3). Seating must be designed in such a fashion to allow all passengers a quick exit and must meet with Best In The Desert Racing Association approval. SDC2: Only entrants that are listed on the official Best In The Desert Racing Association entry form may drive or co-drive in the vehicle for which they are registered. In the event in an emergency, any registered arm banded racer may get in may race vehicle, but the registered racer must notify a Best In The Desert race official. Registration is limited to a maximum of four entrants per vehicle.
